1. Review / Discussion for Events and Fundraising Plans:

a. Spirit Nights- Monthly (**Jackie Forte**)

c. Spirit Wear Online Store (**Tyra and ?**):

i. New student Spirit Wear Sale, we could also offer a Senior T-Shirt (design TBD)

ii. Dates: April 6-20 (may open store longer and earlier), delivery May 1

d. Dance (8th Grade)-Spring, April 25, 2026 (**Lauren and Tiffany**)

i. CCA approved with caveat: it is the day after the Prom and so HS and Administration would not be able to support preparation or event

ii. Recommended we ask MS staff and parents for volunteer support

iii. CCA is willing to pay all or a portion of the security cost (TBD)

iv. Creation of 8th Grade Dance questionnaire Google Form- send to Mary, she will e-mail it to 8th grade students

2. Voting:

- a. New funding request: Storage Room Organization- \$1,000-\$1,200
 - i. Shelving (permanent and adjustable) and storage bins
 - ii. Build out to support year-round and seasonal storage requirements
 - iii. Request that National Honor Society help with inventory, design, organization, and management (if they need volunteer hours)
 - iv. Work with Bob Pegram and Micah Tyler for design requirements
- b. Funding request: Signage for Front of School \$1,000- **Approved, but not funded**



3. CCA Administration Meeting Notes:

- a. *Is CCA planning an Athletic Banquet (MS and HS) with recognition for 8th-grade and 12th-grade players?*- Will allow teams to continue to organize their own events. Seniors recognized for Conference, State, and National achievements in sports would be recognized at the Senior Awards Banquet
- b. *Is CCA planning an Academic Banquet (MS and HS) with recognition for students?*- Yes, they will be similar to last year's events, a morning event for 8th grade and an awards banquet for the seniors, recognizing academic achievement and scholarships
- c. *Lock in Fall Dance date for 26/27 school year to ensure PTO has lead-*
Approved, PTO can determine if clubs/organizations may be allowed to do a fundraising opportunity during the dance
- d. *Discuss "No Fuss Fundraiser" with CCA Administration to raise money for the gym-* Yes, they support
 - i. Change from "Gym" to "Facilities Growth" Fundraiser, work with School Funder (Greg has contact), post on School and PTO Social Media to increase reach

- ii. CCA will prepare an information sheet about the proposed usage of the money raised and the school growth plan
- iii. PTO will create Sponsorship levels for giving amounts- like silver, gold, platinum and think of how sponsors would be recognized
- iv. PTO and student family members will be encouraged to help gain company and corporate donations
- v. Identify PTO members who would like to take the lead for this initiative
